## **Daily Confession of Faith**



This is the day the Lord has made. I will rejoice and be glad in it (Ps 118:24).

I enter into this day confessing that you, Lord, my God, are one (Deut 6:4), A Trinity of persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Mat 28:19).

You are the one, true, living God (1 Thes 1:9), besides whom there is no other (Is 45:6).

I cry with all the heavenly host:

“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord; who was and is and is to come” (Rev 4:8).


This day I renew my baptism by rejecting sin and living for God in Christ Jesus (Ro 6:11)

This day I refuse to be mastered by sin (Ro 6:14).

This day it is my will to give no foothold to the devil (Eph 4:27).

Rather, I believe in God, the Father, almighty, my Father, who is the maker of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, my Savior, who was born under the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilot, was crucified, died and was buried; on the third day he rose again, and will come to judge the living and



the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sin, and life everlasting.

This day, Lord, let your presence go with me (Ex 33:14), hem me in, before and behind (Ps 139: 5). In baptism I have received the Holy Spirit (Ac 2:38), therefore, I cry out “Abba, Father” (Ro 8:15). Father, I seek first your kingdom (Mat 6:33). May your kingdom come and your will be done in my life (Mat 6:10). To walk in your will, I receive your guidance (Is 30:21) and your correction (Heb 12:6). I open my heart to your voice which is behind me saying, “This is the way, walk in it.” (Is 30:21) I am not fearful, but I move in power, love, and self-control (2 Tim 1:6). I offer my life as a living sacrifice. This day, I will not be conformed to the world but I will be transformed by the renewing of my mind that I might prove what is your good, pleasing acceptable will (Ro 12:1-2).

**Jesus, you are my savior (Ac 4:12).**

**Jesus, you are my Lord (Phil 2:1).**

You have bought me at the price of your blood (1 Cor 6:20). Because of you, Jesus, I have direct access to the Father (Heb 4:16). Because of you, Jesus, my sins are forgiven (Col 1:14), for your blood has cleansed me of all unrighteousness (1 Jn 1:7). Because of you, Jesus, there is no condemnation for me (Ro 8:1). Because of you, Jesus, I am seated in heavenly places (Eph 2:6). Because of you, Jesus, I have been given fullness (Col 2:10) and you will meet all my needs, this day, according to your glorious riches (Phil 4:19). Because of you, Jesus, this day, every spiritual blessing is mine (Eph 1:3).

This day I know who I am and the mission to which I have been called, for in my baptism I was anointed and appointed to be priest, prophet and king.

**I am a priest**, so this day I will worship the King and make intercession for all the needs of the Kingdom.

**I am a prophet**, so this day I will teach all I meet the Gospel of the Kingdom.

**I am a king**, so this day I will bring everything I say and do under the authority of the Kingdom of God.

**Today, Holy Spirit,  
increase my faith,  
strengthen my hope  
and deepen my love (1 Cor 13:13).**

Holy Spirit, be my helper, abide in me, and lead me to all truth (Jn 14:16-17). I am your temple (1 Cor 6:19) and I am filled with you, Holy Spirit (Eph 5:18). I choose to abide in Christ (Jn 15:5), so I will bear the fruit of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness and self-control (Gal 5:25). Spirit of the living God be sealed afresh in me (Eph 4:30) as on the day of my Confirmation and grant me **fear of the Lord, piety, counsel, wisdom, fortitude, knowledge and understanding (Is 11:2-3)**. For the sake of the building up of the body, the Church (1 Cor 12:7) I desire the spiritual gifts (1 Cor 14:1) and I desire an abundance of them in my life (1 Cor 14:12) **I desire the word of knowledge, and the word of wisdom. I desire faith, healings, miracles, and prophecy. I desire discerning of spirits, tongues and interpretation of tongues (1 Cor 12:8-10).** Use me to do your works as I ask in Jesus’ name (Jn 14:12).

Today, my love will be sincere (Ro 12:9) and I will love others as Christ has loved me (Jn 15:12).

Today, if I am hurt or offended, knowingly or unknowingly, rightly or wrongly, I chose to forgive even as I have been forgiven (Col 3:13) and I ask forgiveness of anyone I will hurt or offend knowingly or unknowingly, rightly or wrongly. I will bless those who curse me, I will do good to those who hate me, and I will pray for those who spitefully use me (Mat 5:44). By these things I will do whatever needs to be done to make peace, thus I will demonstrate that I am a child of God (Mat 5:9). This day, I am not overcome by evil, but I overcome evil with good (Ro 12:21).

This day I will not be lacking in zeal, but I will keep my spiritual fervor serving the Lord (Ro 12:11).

I have been given freely, so freely will I give (Mt 10:8) and I will excel in my giving (2 Cor 8:7).

This day I will share with all God’s people who are in need (Ro 12:13).

I do nothing out of selfish ambition, but I consider others better than myself (Phil 2:3).

I am a servant (Mat 23:11).

I will look for opportunities to practice the corporeal acts of mercy by feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, visiting the prisoner, sheltering the homeless, visiting the sick and burying the dead.

I will also practice the spiritual works of mercy by admonishing the sinner, instructing the ignorant, counseling the doubtful, comforting the sorrowful, bearing all wrongs patiently, forgiving all injuries, and praying for the living and the dead.

Today is set before me a blessing and a curse, life and death and I choose life that I might live (Deut 30:19), I choose the abundant life that Jesus came to bring me (Jn 10:10).

I reject all negative emotions of fear, loneliness, anger, lust, greed, pride, I apply to the doorpost of my life and the lives of all my family and friends, the blood of the Lamb (Ex 12:13).

I am strong in the Lord and the power of his might.

I place on myself the armor of God that I may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil: I gird my loins with truth and have on the breast place of righteousness. My feet are shod with readiness for the Gospel of peace. I take the shield of faith that I might extinguish the fiery darts of the wicked. I take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God.

I pray in the Spirit making supplication for all the saints and that utterance and boldness may be given to all who open their mouths to make known the mystery of the Gospel. (Eph 6:10-19).

I submit to God and I resist the devil and he must flee (Jas 4:11).

No weapon formed against me this day shall prosper (Is 54:17).

In the name of Jesus I break every curse, hex and spell that has been uttered against me.

This day every foul spirit that would come against me I command to bend its knee to the name of Jesus (Phil 2:10). I proclaim a hedge of protection (Job 1:10) for myself, my family, my friends and the Church around our spiritual life, our health, our emotions, our finances, our relationships,
