Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Resurrection of our Lord come down into (name of the person) soul that they might be convinced that Christ alone us their source of peace.

Ascension of Our Lord (Ac 1:6-12)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Ascension of our Lord come down into (name of the person) soul that they might serve him who is King of kings and Lord of lords.

“blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, to whom (name of the person) will submit as Lord of his/her life.”

Descent of the Holy Spirit (Ac 2:1-41)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Descent of the Holy Spirit come down into (name of the person) soul that they might be filled afresh with the Holy Spirit as on the day of their Baptism and Confirmation.

“blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, with whose Spirit (name of the person) has been filled.”

Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary come down into (name of the person) soul that they might live for God and God alone.

“blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who longs to share all his blessings with (name of the person) .”

Coronation of Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth (Rev 12:1)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Coronation of Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth come down into (name of the person) soul that they might come to share in the life of the Saints in heaven someday.

“blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who waits in joyful expectation for (name of the person) in heaven.”

and of the Holy Spirit.

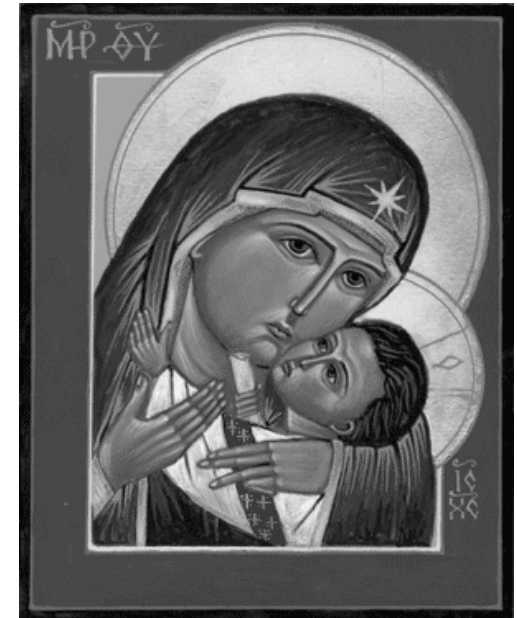

Rosary for a Fallen away Child



The first most powerful prayer that we can make for our children is have the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass offered for their conversion.

The second most powerful prayer is that of the Most Holy Rosary. You might even want to offer a Novena Rosary, which is the Rosary said for Nine consecutive days, with the intention of your child's conversion. Here is a method of praying the Rosary for your child's conversion.

After the mystery of the Rosary is announced, say the following

“Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of ...”

*You might also add in the Hail Mary,
“blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who is”*

*Or add, “Holy Mary, Mother of God pray for (name of the person),
now and at the hour of their death. AMEN.”*



Joyful Mysteries

Annunciation and Incarnation (Lk 1:26-38)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Annunciation come down into (name of the person) soul that their guardian angel might invite them back into union with the Lord Jesus and he/she would respond with "Let it be done to me according to your word."
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who is the lover of (name of person) soul"

Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth (Lk 1:39-56)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Visitation come down into (name of the person) soul that see and remember the mighty things that God has done for him/her.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who has done great things for (name of the person)."

Birth of Our Lord (Lk 2:1-20)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Birth of our Lord come down into (name of the person) soul that they might humbly make room for Jesus in their life.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, whose delight is to dwell in the heart of (name of the person)."

Presentation of Our Lord (Lk 2:22-38)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Presentation come down into (name of the person) soul that they might re-present their life in surrender to the Father.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who comes to bring (name of the person) to the Father."

Finding Child Jesus in the Temple (Lk 2:41-52)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Finding in the Temple come down into (name of the person) soul that a hunger might awaken in his/her heart to search after God.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who hungers and thirsts for (name of the person)."

Luminous Mysteries

Baptism of our Lord Jesus (Mk 1:9-11)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Baptism of our Lord Jesus come down into (name of the person) soul that they might remember who they have become through the waters of Baptism, a son/daughter of God.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, in whom (name of the person) has become a son/daughter of God."

Wedding Feast at Cana (Jn 2:1-12)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Wedding Feast at Cana come down into (name of the person) soul that they might allow Christ to change their life from water to wine, from ordinary to the extra-ordinary life of grace.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who is able to bring change (name of the person)."

Proclamation of the Kingdom (Mt 4:17)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Proclamation of the Kingdom come down into (name of the person) soul that they might repent and recommit their life to the Kingdom.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, wishes to grant the grace of repentance so that he might be the King of (name of the person) life."

Transfiguration of Our Lord (Mt 17:1-8)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Transfiguration come down into (name of the person) soul that they begin to listen in prayer so as to hear the voice of the Father.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who desires to teach (name of the person) to hear the voice of the Father."

Institution of the Eucharist (Mt 26:26-30)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Institution of the Eucharist come down into (name of the person) soul that they might reaffirm their belief in Christ as the Eucharist Lord and return to all the Sacraments.

Sorrowful Mysteries

Agony in the Garden (Lk 22:39-46)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Agony in the Garden come down into (name of the person) soul that they might again cultivate a life of prayer.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who can teach (name of the person) how to pray."

Scourging at Pillar (Jn 19:1-3)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Scourging at the Pillar come down into (name of the person) soul that they might be healed of anything that has lead them to turn away.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who is (name of the person) healer."

Crowning with Thorns (Mt 27:29)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Crowning of Thorns come down into (name of the person) soul that his/her intellect might submit to Divine Revelation.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who longs to reveal the truth to (name of the person)."

Carrying the Cross (Mk 15:20-21)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Carrying of the Cross come down into (name of the person) soul that they might deny themselves and accept the will of God.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, whose will is perfect for (name of the person)."

Crucifixion and Death of our Lord (Jn 19:16-37)

Through mediation on this mystery and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary may the grace of the Crucifixion and Death of our Lord come down into (name of the person) soul that they might be set free of any feelings of being abandoned by God.
"blessed is the fruit of your womb Jesus, who can heal reveal the Father's unconditional love to (name of the person)."
